


## A Woman with Altitude

Emma Slade, the only western woman fully ordained in Bhutan, has dedicated her life to serving others through compassion, wisdom, and action. Her life changed exponentially after she was held at gunpoint in her hotel room in Jakarta. From financial analyst to Buddhist nun, she is now an established author, inspirational teacher, and an advanced meditator. She now faces her most formidable challenge yet: conquering the Wild Bhutan Trail, an unforgiving 403km route crossing 12 mountains over 37 days. It's wild and untouched; very few have made the entire journey, and it is intentionally left literally to the wild to reduce any impact on nature. It's arduous, surprising and virtually unseen.
